

# Photography Tuition with Daniel Bridge


Level 1 Photography Workshop – 'Know The Basics'  
The Naze Education and Visitor Centre  
Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2016

Daniel Bridge is running a one-day workshop designed to help you get the most from your camera. Baffled by ISO, aperture, P,A,S and M? All these and more are covered during the morning session, with a slideshow and discussion guiding you through the main controls common to all cameras.

After a break for lunch, we go out on the Naze to put our new-found knowledge to good use, trying out the controls on the cameras and seeing the differences we can make to our photos.

## Aims of the Day

To improve your photography! An alternative title for this workshop might have been 'Get me off Green mode', as we want you to explore the ways in which you can control your camera, and gain greater satisfaction from your photography. We will use diagrams, text, examples and more to show you what the different functions are, how you can control them, and how you can apply them for your benefit.



## What you need to know

Nothing! As long as you can switch the camera on, everything else will be covered on the day. If you do know some of the basics though, don't worry, there'll be plenty more here for you to learn.

## What you need to bring

*A camera!* This is mainly aimed at digital cameras of all types, but even if you use film, you will gain extra knowledge about your camera.

*A Tripod* if you have one. Don't worry if you don't.

*Memory Cards/Film/Spare Batteries.* We'll be trying many different techniques and it would be a shame to feel limited by the number of exposures you could take, so make sure there's plenty of space on memory cards, or bring a few rolls of film.

Ensure any spare batteries are fully charged!

*Any lenses/accessories you may have.* You never know when you might need them.

*Footwear and Clothing suitable for a walk in the park.* Including wet weather gear (hopefully not required).



## Itinerary

The day starts at 10.00a.m. at the Visitor Centre, at the Naze.

The morning session consists of a classroom based slideshow and discussion about techniques, subjects and equipment.

In the afternoon we will go out onto the nature reserve to explore what we have covered in the morning, allowing some one-to-one time with each participant. We will return to the Visitor Centre at around 4.00pm, completing the workshop.
